



Re: Proposed Stops Signs at Maple Ave. and West St.

A request for a three-way stop at the intersection of Maple Ave. and West St. was made by Mr. Alan Flam, a Town resident, to the Town Council. The matter was brought to my attention by Phil Hervey, the Town Manager. I surveyed the intersection and wholeheartedly agree with Mr. Flam who accurately described the current conditions when he wrote:

"We are writing to request that consideration be given to install STOP Signs at the intersection of Maple Avenue and West Street making it a Three-Way-Stop. This intersection is highly trafficked in the midst of a densely populated residential neighborhood that is also a Neighborhood Business Zone."

Therefore, I am recommending the Town Council consider adding three stops to govern the intersection of Maple Ave. and West St. A check with the Police Department's Records Management System shows 15 accidents on Maple Ave. and 2 accidents on West St. for 2021. The change will enhance public safety.
