ORDINANCE No. 2022-5

AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT TO THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF BARRINGTON

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of Barrington, Rhode Island, that the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Barrington be amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 144 - PUBLIC LANDS, USE OF

* * *

Sec. 144-17. Littering prohibited.

- (a) No person shall throw, drop, deposit, discard, or otherwise dispose of litter upon any public property in the Town or in the waters of this Town or upon private property in this Town except:
- (1) When the property is designated by the Town for the disposal of solid waste or litter, and the person is authorized to use the property for that purpose; or
- (2) Into a litter receptacle in a manner that the litter will be prevented from being carried away by the elements.
- (b) As used in this section, "litter" means garbage, trash, waste, rubbish, ashes, cans, bottles, wire, paper, cartons, boxes, automobile parts, furniture, glass, or anything else of an unsightly or unsanitary nature thrown, dropped, discarded, placed, or deposited by a person on public property, on private property not owned by the person, or in or on waters of the Town.
- (c) Violators of this Ordinance shall be subject to the following penalties:
 - (1) First offense: warning
 - (2) Second offense: Fifty dollar (\$50.00) fine
 - (3) Third/subsequent offenses during a one year period: One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) fine

CHAPTER 134 – PARKS AND RECREATION ARTICLE I – GENERAL REGULATIONS

* * *

Sec. 134-3. Rubbish.

A. General. There shall be no deposit of trash in any public park or beach of the Town of Barrington. Each person shall be responsible for removing trash brought into the public park or

beach and the associated parking areas. <u>Violators shall be subject to the penalties specified in Sec. 144-17(c).</u>
