12	through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act); and

14	Whereas, a clause within the CARES act allows the state to use the federal funds to issue grants
15	to small businesses; and
16	
17	Whereas, The State of Rhode Island has failed to properly set up a streamlined small business
18	grant application; and
19	
20	Whereas, The State of Rhode Island has discriminated against the largest part of the small
21	business industry, sole proprietorships, which make up 73 percent of business across the country
22	according to the small business administration; and
23	
24	Whereas, The State of Rhode Island has intentionally not distributed these funds for interest
25 26	collection purposes as well as currently unapproved usage for their own budget; and
27	Whereas, businesses across the state are closing at an unprecedented rate; and
28	vincicas, businesses across the state are crossing at an unprecedented rate, and
29	Whereas, the Cumberland Town Council believes the State of Rhode Island has mismanaged the
30	CARES Act funds in spite of their intended purpose.

32	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CUMBERLAND TOWN COUNCIL
33	OF CUMBERLAND, RHODE ISLAND AS FOLLOWS:

35	SECTION 1: That The Cumberland Town Council hereby supports the request to have The
36	State of Rhode Island expedite, streamline acceptance, and distribute the previously approved
