Re: Resignation from Westerly Harbor Management Commission

Dear Ms. LeBlanc,

I am writing to you to resign from the Westerly Harbor Management Commission. I was appointed in April 2023 for a two year term and had intended to notify the Town that I did not wish to be reappointed in 2025. Unfortunately, a medical condition has prompted me to resign several months early. I have notified the Commission and am copying the chairperson in this letter.

It was a privilege to work with the fine people on the Commission and with the Town Council Liaison, Joy Cordio. I believe everyone involved worked diligently and in good faith on behalf of the Town of Westerly. However, in my opinion, the Commission was not treated with the respect they earned through their hard work and those involved were further subject to constant unsolicited and highly unprofessional and unethical conduct by a certain Council member who need not be named since he is no longer on the Council. While this is not why I am leaving the Commission, I believe it is important to document this issue in my letter of resignation. My primary reason for leaving is that we will be transitioning to our home in New Hampshire and declare that address our permanent legal residence.

I sincerely hope that the Town bolsters the good people on the Harbor Management Commission with new appointees who have a similar work ethic and strong desire to improve the shoreline and coastal waters of Westerly for the benefit of **ALL** residents and visitors alike.
