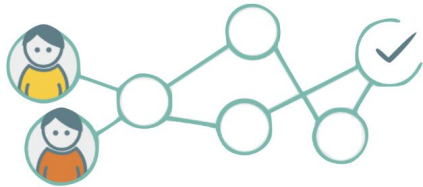

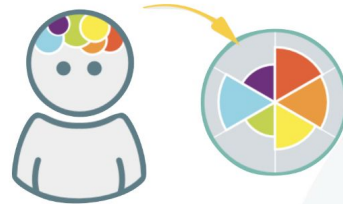

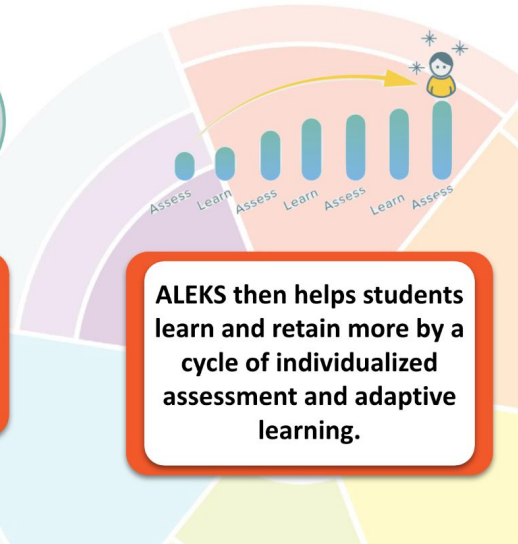
Assessment and Learning in Knowledge Spaces
