**AN AMENDMENT TO THE
ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF BARRINGTON
Alcoholic Beverages**

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Barrington, Rhode Island, that Chapter 63, Article I, Section 1 of the Town Code be amended as follows:

CHAPTER 63. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Article I – Possession and Consumption

§ 63-1. Possession and consumption on public property prohibited.

No person shall, on public property owned by the Town of Barrington, possess, an open container or consume any intoxicating beverage without the prior approval of the Barrington Town Manager; provided, however, that nothing herein shall prohibit the lawful transportation of such intoxicating beverages on the streets and highways of the Town of Barrington. For purposes of this section, the term "intoxicating beverage" shall have the same meaning as contained in § 3-1-1 of the Rhode Island General Laws (as amended) as the same now exists or may hereafter be amended.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Barrington, Rhode Island, that Chapter 63, Article I, Section 1 of the Town Code be amended as follows:

CHAPTER 63. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Article I – Possession and Consumption

§ 63-1. Possession and consumption on public property prohibited.

No person shall, on public property owned by the Town of Barrington, possess or consume any intoxicating beverage without the prior approval of the Barrington Town Manager; provided, however, that nothing herein shall prohibit the lawful transportation of such intoxicating beverages on the streets and highways of the Town of Barrington. For purposes of this section, the term "intoxicating beverage" shall have the same meaning as contained in § 3-1-1 of the Rhode Island General Laws (as amended) as the same now exists or may hereafter be amended.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
